

Vasvár

Well of Kings: A musical fountain (a well playing music), which represents the history of the town, was made in the year of the Millennium. www.vasvar.hu

Szentgotthárd

Aquapark with outdoor games for children: The thermal park offers many outdoor recreation opportunities for the smallest and biggest ones like. There are football table, beach volleyball court, swings, springboard and a Home Ball arena. www.thermalpark.hu



City Cooperation II



Adventure city for children

Children-friendly attractions and certain points of the adventure city route for children are collected in the tourist map.

1. Playground

The renovated playground offers a hexagonal swing, a playing tower, cableways, a sand pit, a climbing frame called "eagle nest", seesaws and an arched bridge with balancing columns for the youngest.

2. Football pitch

The football pitch is a fake grass pitch of 20x40 metres with planks and is located in the area of Gyula Andrassy Primary School.

3. Tale bridge

As part of the city rehabilitation programme a new "Tale bridge" is being built near Béci-stream instead of the worn-out and demolished wooden bridge. (Delivery: Spring 2020)

4. Szapáry-Andrássy Castle and Park with the old plane tree

The Szapáry-Andrássy Castle built by the Szapáry family in the mid-1700s in baroque style and currently operating as a cultural centre came into the possession of the Andrassy family through marriage who rebuilt it during the 1800s with classicist elements. This place is remarkable not only as an architectural and historical heritage but also because of its beautiful park with ancient trees, where it is worth take the time to see the 500-year-old giant plane tree: it is 20 metre high, has a circumference of 615 cm and was selected as the tree of the year in 2010. There are also a number of other magnificent plants to admire here.

5. "Fáklya" Cultural Centre and Library

It has been the intellectual centre and a platform for building communities since Letenye became a town and had the same purpose earlier as well. It serves the city by implementing and managing cultural activities. The twelve-sided pavilion considered as an excellent example of organic architecture was built from only natural materials in 1993 based on the design of the architect Ervin Nagy. It is a special, eye-catching work that also became the symbol of Letenye.

6. Letenye City Thermal Spa and Camping

Letenye Beach and Thermal Spa are located under the old oak trees and copper beeches in the ancient park of Szapáry Castle near the Castle Park offering air full of ozone. Besides the pools, the green area of three hectares also includes a camping, volley-ball and beach football courts. The large pool of 33 m x 20 m, the round pool for children with UV insulating solar sails and blinds and the sitting and training pool also protected with solar sails were built on a thermal water of 50 °C containing calcium, magnesium, and hydrogen carbonate.

8. "Fáma Háza"

"Fáma Háza" is the home to the memory room of "Mrs Sándor Keszei"; most of the inheritance of Mrs Sándor Keszei, master of folk art; Letenye room - where traditional clothing of Letenye is presented; and a display kitchen where visitors can taste traditional local food. The spices of their own spice garden are used for seasoning.

9. Statue of Flórián

was erected in 1756 now located at Furgyán-square.

10. Cycling Centre

The cycling centre established from more than 80 million forints is a place for relaxation. The fully equipped cycling centre delivered in June 2019 welcomes tourists. There are resting places and info-points in Letenye and its neighbourhood and information boards were also placed along the roads available for bikers. Routes recommended to tourists are indicated on the boards placed along the educational path. There is nearly a 100 km long route for bikers between Letenye, Prelog and Ludbreg.

11. Gravel quarry of Fényes

The gravel quarry of Fényes located in the neighbourhood of the town used to be a favourite place of local fishermen. Now it is a fishing pond again and officially opens its doors to fishermen and hikers, as fishery management rights were granted to the Zala County Association of the Fishermen Clubs until 2030.

12. Blessed Buzád lookout tower

It is located on the Zajki hill with a beautiful view to Zala hills and vineyards. The lookout tower was also built for wine tourism as a project mutually managed by the local governments of Letenye and Zajk.

13. Boronapince

"Boronapince" is a safe haven from where there is a magnificent view to the city below and as well as the Mura valley.
