6. Description of the contract

TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

8. Eligibility and rules of origin

Participation is open to all legal persons [participating either individually or in a grouping (consortium) of tenderers] which are established in a Member State of the European Union or in a country or territory of the regions covered and/or authorised by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed (see also heading 22 below). All works, supplies and services under this contract must originate in one or more of these countries. Participation is also open to international organisations. The participation of natural persons is directly governed by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed.

9. Grounds for exclusion

Tenderers must submit a signed declaration, included in the Tender Form for a Works Contract, to the effect that they are not in any of the situations listed in point 2.3.3 of the **Practical Guide** to contract procedures for EU external actions.

10. Number of tenders

Tenderers may submit only one tender per lot. Tenders for parts of a lot will not be considered. Any tenderer may state in its tender that it would offer a discount in the event that its tender is accepted for more than one lot. Tenderers may not submit a tender for a variant solution in addition to their tender for the works required in the tender dossier.

11. Tender guarantee

Tenderers must provide a tender guarantee of 16.000,- Euros when submitting their tender. This guarantee will be released to unsuccessful tenderers once the tender procedure has been completed and to the successful tenderer upon signature of the contract by all parties.

12. Performance guarantee

The successful tenderer will be asked to provide a performance guarantee of 5 % of the amount of the contract at the signing of the contract. This guarantee must be provided together with the return of the countersigned contract no later than 30 days after the tenderer receives the contract signed by the Contracting Authority. If the selected tenderer fails to provide such a guarantee within this period, the contract will be void and a new contract may be drawn up and sent to the tenderer which has submitted the next cheapest compliant tender.

Tenders must remain valid for a period of 90 days after the deadline for submission of tenders.

SELECTION AND AWARD CRITERIA

16. Selection criteria

The candidate shall prove his technical and financial ability as indicated in the tender dossier.

The following selection criteria will be applied to candidates. In the case of applications submitted by a consortium, these selection criteria will be applied to the consortium as a whole:

1.) Economic and financial capacity of the candidate:

In case of applicant being a public body, equivalent information should be provided.

- a. The tenderer's total net annual turnover, based on the simple mathematical average of the previous three years' net turnover (2009, 2010, 2011) does not reach HUF 400.000.000,- and for the same period the simple mathematical average of net turnover for water infrastructure construction does not reach net HUF 250.000.000,-.
- b. Based on the financial reports complying with the accountancy law, in the previous three closed financial years the Tenderer's or its predecessor's in title profit after tax and dividends is positive.
- c. based on the declarations by the relevant financial institution in two years prior to the tender announcement there was no queuing at one of the bank accounts of the Tenderer and in case of loan the Tenderer fulfilled its re-payment duties punctually and on time.

2.) Professional capacity of candidate:

- a. The Tenderer must have the following professional staff required in order to perform the task:
- at least one chief engineer in charge (Category B), working in water management infrastructure, who has at least five years of experience and is registered as outlined in the 2.2 point of appendix 1 (MV-VZ/B) of the government decree nr 244/2006. (XII. 05)
- at least one chief engineer in charge (Category A), working in Buildings and building services engineering and who has at least three years of experience and is registered as outlined 1.5 point of appendix 1 (MV-ÉP/ÉG) of the government decree nr 244/2006. (XII. 05)
- at least 1 designer with water engineering designing license (VZ-T) and one designer with Geotechnical designer (GT-T)license and chamber membership, who all have at least three years of experience.
- at least 1 designers with license for environmental protection expertise (SZKV-vf Water and geologic medium protection and SZKV-hu – Waste management environmental protection) and cahmber membership, who each has at least three years of experience
- b. In each of the examined three years (2009, 2010, 2011) the statistical average of the employees' number at the Tenderer must be at least 15 people.

c. The Tenderer must have certificates of MSZ EN ISO 9001:2009 and 14001:2004 accredited in any national system, lacking this, a proof about an environmental protection management system equaling to the standard.

3.) Technical capacity of candidate:

- a. The Tenderer, in order to perform the task, must have the following engineering and technical equipment: :
- 1 piece of 22-ton tracked excavator
- 1 piece of 16,5-ton rotating excavator
- 2 pieces of excavator-loader
- 1 piece of self-propelled vibratory compactor combination cylinder of 2,5 t
- 1 piece of compressor of 8 bar
- 1 db aggregator with performance of 1 MW
- 4 pieces of engine pumps with a capacity of 1.000 l/minute
- 1 piece of 18-ton truck
- 1 piece of 28-ton truck
- 1 piece of hydraulic road drill
- b. The Tenderer, from two years prior to the tender announcement, (since April 2010) two references of designing and planning connected to water infrastructure investment, whereas the net value of investment should be at least HUF 250 million each, and at least one of them should have been carried out in the framework of EU co-financing.
- c. The Tenderer, from two years prior to the tender announcement, (since April 2010) must have at least two completed references, including building waste water plant or water plant, worth of net HUF 250 million each, and at least one of them should have been carried out in the framework of EU co-financing. (EEOP, ROP, IPA etc)

In case of the relevant contract, the economic player, if required, is allowed to utilise other units' capacity regardless of their legal relation. The Contracting Authority may not accept these if the offer is including other units' capacity in majority or if the Tenderer is not able to perform the key criteria alone. If the Tenderer utilises others' capacity then he must prove that the required resources are at his disposal to accomplish the contract, for example he is collecting guarantees from the companies that the necessary resources will be at the Tenderer's disposal in the given area. These companies, for example the mother company of the economic player, must comply with the same criteria, especially the condition of origin, as the Tenderer. In addition, the relevant data of the third party according to the selection criteria must be included in the offer separated. If the Contracting Authority requires, documents proving the Tenderer's capacity should be made available.
